What - Coffee Beer Contest featuring BeCaffeinated coffee

When - February Meeting, 18 Feb 2025

Where - Be Caffeinated, Northshore Location, 14 W. Kent Street, Chattanooga, TN

Who - Barley Mob and members of BeCaffeinated staff, specifically Luke Pigott - head coffee roaster.

Beer Contest Rules

- Must use BeCaffeinated coffee. The coffee is donated to Barley Mob brewers as either
 whole beans or liquid coffee concentrate. Whole beans will be made available at the
 December meeting. The liquid coffee concentrate will be available at the January
 meeting.
- 2. Beer can be any base style, but brewer must declare base style per BJCP guidelines for SHV beers, Cat 30A is typical, but is not limited to that category. Consider 30D, Specialty Spice Beers would also be a valid category.
- 3. This is a three-bottle contest. Two bottles will be used by Barley Mob judges to determine the top three beers, and one bottle will be used by Be Caffeinated staff to evaluate the best coffee character. There will be a total of four awards. A brewer can win two awards.

More Fun Stuff

- 1. The Be Caffeinated location has two gathering areas;
 - a. Covered/plastic enclosed/heated area
 - b. Covered, but open area. The enclosed heated area will be used for judging.
- 2. Bottle Share While the judging is going on, the open area can be used for bottle sharing. Because Be Caffeinated typically closes at 6pm, our semi-private event is not limited by licensing limitations.
- 3. Once judging is complete. We can bring both groups together in the heated area for awards and continued celebration.
