Beer Contest Rules

- 1. You must use BeCaffeinated coffee. The coffee is donated to Barley Mob brewers as either whole beans or liquid coffee concentrate. Whole beans were distributed at the December meeting, and liquid coffee concentrate was distributed at the January meeting. Thank you, Andy, for running out to pick up some Mason Jars for the crew last night. Tom W. still has two of the 8oz bags of whole bean coffee if anyone still wants to join in.
- 2. Beer can be any base style, but brewer must declare base style per BJCP guidelines for SHV beers, Cat 30A is typical, but is not limited to that category. Consider 30D, Specialty Spice Beers would also be a valid category.
- 3. This is a **three-bottle** contest. Two bottles will be used by Barley Mob judges to determine the top three beers, and one bottle will be used by Be Caffeinated staff to evaluate the best coffee character. There will be a total of four awards. A brewer can win two awards. Beer Win/Place/Show Awards will be Medals. The Coffee Expression Award will be a gift certificate from Beverage World.
- 4. ** Please label your beers using the SCP_BottleID.pdf form found <u>HERE</u>. Attach labels with rubber bands to each bottle. If you have a problem downloading the file, let Ritchie know and he can send it to you directly.
- 5. We need folks to be on time for the meeting to submit their beers and to be evaluated.
